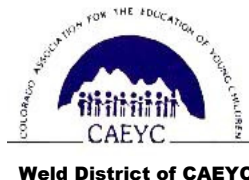

This training will be held at  
Weld County Training Center  
1104 H Street

From Highway 34

- Head East on Highway 34
- Turn left on either 35th Ave or 11th Ave
- Follow directions for each route

From 35th Ave

- Head North on 35th Ave
- Turn right on O Street, heading East
- Proceed 1 1/2 miles on O street
- Turn right on North 17th Ave, heading South
- Continue down North 17th Ave
- Turn right into the parking lot just before the stop sign at H street and 11th Ave

From 11th Ave

- Head North on 11th Ave
- Turn left on H Street, heading West
- Proceed to the first entrance on the right hand side of H street
- Turn right
- Turn right at the first intersection
- Turn right at the Stop sign
