### Q: What is Young Leaders Society (YLS)?

A Young Leaders Society program exists at nearly 100 United Ways and in 2007, those programs raised \$40 million in support of communities throughout the United States.

YLS will bring together young leaders with a common interest in improving the lives of others and bettering communities in Weld County. Participants will become successful community leaders through empowerment, education, and volunteer opportunities.

### Q: What are the membership requirements?

- Must be between the ages of 18-40
- Must participate yearly in two volunteer projects organized by UWCC or YLS
- A personal contribution through United Way of Weld County of \$500, which can be made through a step-up program. The step-up program allows donors to contribute a minimum of \$150 their first year, \$300 their second year, and step-up to \$500 by the third year.
