Weld County-Wide Initiatives and Goals

By 2024, the Reading Great by 8 community-wide goal is to increase the percentage of Weld County children reading to learn by the beginning of 4th Grade from 39% to 43%.

By 2024, the Thrive by 25 community-wide goal is to increase the percentage of Weld County youth who have a connection to a caring adult to 75%.

By 2024, the Weld's Way Home community-wide goal is to decrease the number of people that are living out-ofdoors or in a car in Greeley/Evans from approximately 236 to fewer than 100.

City of Evans, City of Greeley and Garden City are now members of the AARP Network of Age-Friendly Communities; the goal is to lead the community in becoming more age friendly.
