2 Veterans Services

QUESTION: *Where you ever a member of the U.S. Armed Services and find yourself in need of Veteran's Services today?*

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Veterans Services Office

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: The Weld County Veterans Services (WCVS) Office is in place to assist Weld County Veterans and their family members. At Weld Project Connect, you will start with the WCVS office. There, you will take a quick survey on your specific veteran service needs and be directed to receive assistance.

Veterans Survey Questions Asked When Visiting Veterans Services

2a. **QUESTION:** Do you need assistance applying for VA benefits?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Veterans Services Office

SERVICE DESCRIPTION:

The Weld County Veterans Service office is in place to assist Weld County Veterans and their family members. We offer assistance with filing of Service Connected disability claims, NSC pension claims, widow's benefits, V.A. educational programs (forms & applications), survivor and burial benefits, and Colorado state veteran's benefits. We offer assistance with retrieving Veterans military service records, discharge certificates, and Service Medical Records. When we cannot directly assist Veterans our job is to direct them to the proper channel of aid. Our office keeps confidential files for our veterans to aid in documenting all paperwork involved in the V.A. claims process. We accomplish our goals of assisting our local veterans by face to face communication in our office, over the phone, and by conducting community outreach. We work with local agencies such as the VFW, American Legion, DAV, and numerous College Veterans benefits offices



2b. QUESTION: Are you a Veteran with significant barriers to employment such as homelessness, criminal record, unemployed, substance abuse and/or recently transitioned?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Veteran Services

SERVICE DESCRIPTION:

The Weld County Veterans Service office is in place to assist veterans and their family members with filing of service connected disability claims, non service connected disability claims, burial and survivor benefits VA health care enrollment, and assist with VA educational programs (forms & applications). We also offer assistance with retrieving military service records, discharge certificates, and service treatment records. When we cannot directly assist veterans our job is to direct them to the proper channel of aid. Our office keeps confidential files for our veterans to aid in documenting all paperwork involved in the VA claims process. We accomplish our goals of assisting our local veterans by face to face communication in our office, over the phone, and by conducting community outreach.

2c. QUESTION: Are you in need of housing stability or landlord negotiation assistance?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Volunteers of America Back Home Program

SERVICE DESCRIPTION:

The Back Home-SSVF program provides intensive case management around housing stability, including veteran's benefit, public benefits, and budgeting to veterans that are currently homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. At Weld Project Connect we will be doing screenings as well as intakes for low income eligible veterans. We will be able to provide veteran-specific information and resources as well as referrals to relevant sources. The take-away items that we will include, but are not limited to, are veteran-specific benefits, crisis intervention cards, and a housing stability benefits packet that will include helpful information and FAQs about housing and the process of gaining housing. We can also assist veterans with housing search assistance as well as landlord negotiation, as needed.

Surviving spouses who do not qualify due to income and assets being too high, we can provide options for discounted rates for services as well.

2d. QUESTION: Are you a Veteran regardless of discharge status or time served and have questions?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Northern Colorado Veterans Resource Center

SERVICE DESCRIPTION:

Veterans no matter time served or discharge status are eligible to enter our program. Our program is no cost to the veteran. All we need is proof of service and we can assist veterans with most financial problems. Our emergency fund covers things like groceries, transportation, first months rent, deposit, utilities, vehicle repairs and hotel stays. We can also assist with referrals for benefits and discharge upgrades. NCVRC works with large network of agencies to make sure veterans are set up for success. Veterans in need of services will do a quick 10 minute intake before being transferred to a case manager for further assistance.

2e. QUESTION: Are you experiencing homelessness and need housing assistance or other VA services?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Veterans Administration

SERVICE DESCRIPTION:

The Cheyenne Veterans Administration Homeless Program provides services to Veterans experiencing homelessness in Northern Colorado and Southeastern Wyoming through a Veteran Housing Voucher program, the Emergency Contract Shelter programs, and the Grant and Per Diem programs. Veterans are also assisted with accessing additional Veterans Administration and non-Veterans Administration Services such as substance abuse treatment (inpatient and outpatient), medical services, mental health services, employment assistance services, Supportive Services for Veteran Family housing stability referrals, and Veterans Benefits Administration. Each program has different eligibility requirements, which is determined through the intake process either on-site or by appointment. We can assist with the enrollment process for VA healthcare services on-site as well. We also provide resources for the Veterans Crisis Line in the form of but not limited to wallet cards, dog tags, bracelets, coasters, and bandannas.

2f. QUESTION: Are you a Veteran looking for employment?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Veterans Employment Services

SERVICE DESCRIPTION:

Veteran Employment Services provides qualified veterans who are experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness, with personalized employment support to give them the ability to create sustainable and meaningful careers. We provide employment services such as locating job opportunities, employment readiness, job-related training, and other job development services for veterans. In addition, we can offer supportive services such as: clothing, tools, supplies, gas cards, bus passes, and other job-related items. We serve Larimer, Weld and Boulder counties. VES operates under the HVRP(Homeless Veteran Re-integration Program) within the US Department of Labor. We work closely with Weld, Larimer and Boulder counties workforce centers to provide wrap around support for our veterans. VES also provides each veteran we place with a year of retention and supportive services. At the Weld County Project Connect, we hope to meet all interested veterans attending and introduce them to our services and support. We also will have staff available to do intakes on the spot to get each veteran started. Our grant qualifications are the veteran is either experiencing literal homelessness or at risk, has a DD214(if the veteran doesn't, we can order one for them) and has a willingness to obtain employment. We are able to work with all discharge statuses with the exception of dishonorable.

3 Child Support

QUESTION: Do you need help with sending, collecting, establishing, or changing your child support payments?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Human Services (WCDHS)

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: WCCSS collects support payments from non-custodial parents and distributes them to the custodial party. We establish paternity and both create and modify support orders. To apply, you need only be the custodian of a minor child or the person paying. We are able to provide applications for services, payment records, assist in modifying payment plans for existing cases, applications to modify the child support obligation (completed and turned in the same day), and notarization services.

RESTRICTIONS: Custodian of child or person paying child support.

4 Child Care Assistance REACH

QUESTION: Do you need assistance in getting paid for providing child care for a friend, family or neighbor?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Human Services (WCDHS)

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: The Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP) is a federally funded program that helps both parents and providers be successful. CCCAP provides financial assistance to eligible families who are working, searching, for employment, in training or in an educational activity, and who need child care services to support their efforts.

RESTRICTIONS:

5 Recovery/Collections

QUESTION: Do you have to pay back any benefits that you received in the past? Example Food Stamps, TANF, Colorado Works, Medicaid, CCAP, LEAP?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Human Services (WCDHS)

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Provides public assistance to eligible individuals and families. Public assistance includes, but is not limited to: Food Assistance, Old Age Pension, Colorado Works and Low-income Child Care.

RESTRICTIONS:

6 Employment Services

QUESTION: Do you need assistance looking for employment and are you registered with “Connecting Colorado”?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Employment Services of Weld County

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Employment Services is a Colorado Workforce Center. The main goal of the agency for job seekers is to provide appropriate services to customers that enhance opportunities in obtaining employment. Services available through the workforce Center include; job referrals, resume, interviewing job application, and transferable skills workshops, access to computers, fax, copiers, and phones for job seeking purposes.

Employment Services staff will be reactivating Connecting Colorado registrations, providing job referrals, and information on additional services that can be accessed through the agency.

If an individual is already accessing services through Employment Services, they may want to make other Project Connect Services a priority at the event.

RESTRICTIONS: Individuals must know their social security number, basic demographic information, and work history to receive services.

7 Resumes

QUESTION: Do you need help putting your resume together?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Resume Services of Weld County

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Assistance provided to help customers develop and publish resumes.

RESTRICTIONS: None

8 Assistance Payments

QUESTION: Do you need to complete an application for Food, TANF, or medical, or cash assistance?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Human Services (WCDHS)
Assistance Payments

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Provides public assistance to eligible individuals and families. Public assistance includes, but is not limited to: Food Assistance, Old Age Pension, Colorado Works and Low-Income Child Care

RESTRICTIONS: Individuals must provide photo ID, birth certificate, social security card, employment information, and pay stubs.

9 Community Outreach

QUESTION: Are you in a crisis situation to include rent and need resources or are you a kinship provider?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Human Services (WCDHS)
Assistance Payments

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Community Outreach can help with kinship supportive services or a one time help emergency service that can help maintain self sufficiency. Through a grant there may be assistance for rent, vehicle repair, relocation outside of Weld county and the state, or utilities just to name a few. There are eligibility requirements that must be met in order to qualify such as being at or below 125% of the federal poverty level, must be able to sustain ongoing, and must be able to provide verifications such as paychecks or a lease. In addition, all income in the household will be considered and all expenses will be considered for approval. The requests will be submitted to a committee who decides the approvals and denials given all the eligibility requirements.

RESTRICTIONS: Some eligibility requirements may apply

10 Birth Certificates

QUESTION: Are you over 18, born in Colorado, and need a copy of your birth certificate?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment (WCDPHE)

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: To provide, free, on-site birth certificate issuance to eligible attendees who are 18 years of age or older, state law requires that an application must be completed and applicant must submit proof of identity in order to be eligible to receive a copy of their birth certificate. The most common forms of proof of identity include: state driver's license/ID, foreign passport, Medicaid or Medicare card, social security card, IRS-taxpayer letter or card, Mexican voter registration card, Colorado Department of Corrections ID card, vehicle registration, most current paycheck stubs (NOTE: depending on the type of identification provided, a secondary form of identification may be required) If the attendee does not have any of these common forms of documentation to establish his or her identity, attendee may wish to stop by the Weld Project Connect/Birth Certificates booth to obtain a comprehensive list of documentation that can be used to establish identity for this purpose.

RESTRICTIONS: Individuals must be over the age of 18 years and have been born in Colorado.

11 Legal Counseling

QUESTION: Do you want to speak to a lawyer about any legal issue?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Legal Services

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Weld County Legal Services will have attorneys to provide basic legal advice to anyone who may have questions regarding a legal issue including family law, civil law, criminal law, immigration matters, probate matters, elder law, adoptions, etc. We also have notaries available.

RESTRICTIONS: None

12 Senior Services

QUESTION: Do you have questions regarding senior services (age 60+)

Senior Services Survey Questions Asked When Visiting Senior Services

QUESTION: Do you need information or assistance for an adult individual (18 or older) who has a disability?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Area Agency on Aging

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: The AAA (Area Agency on Aging) provides a wide range of information and services to help high-risk, older adults to live with independence and dignity in their homes and communities. We have 3 units: Older Americans Act, Options for Long Term Care, and Adult Protective Services. The Older Americans Act may provide Assistance with chore vouchers; dental, vision, & hearing vouchers; family caregiver support; grandparents raising grandchildren; in-home services; senior nutrition; wellness classes; and advocate for individuals in nursing homes or assisted livings. Options for Long-Term Care provides functional assessments and ongoing case management for low income clients who are in need of long term care services. Adult Protective Services receives reports of abuse, neglect, and exploitation of at-risk adults, conducts investigations and implements services to reduce and prevent further mistreatment. We primarily serve Weld County residents who are 60 and older or 18 and older with a disability.

RESTRICTIONS: age 60 plus or as listed above or age 18 with a disability

12b. QUESTION: Do you need transportation to medical appointments, grocery stores, financial and government institutions, social events, and/or personal grooming appointments?

SERVICE PROVIDER: 60 + Ride

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: 60 + Ride fka/Senior Resource Services (SRS) transports seniors free of charge, regardless of income, through the use of a volunteer transportation program. Clients must be 60 or older, live in Weld County, and be able to walk to and get in a vehicle with no more than an aluminum walker or an arm-assist for balance. At Weld Project Connect we will be focused on educating potential clients about our service and signing up those who need them.

RESTRICTIONS: Age 60 plus

12c. QUESTION: Are you in need of a case manager to advocate for you to gain assistance?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Catholic Charities

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: We serve isolated seniors (age 60+) across Weld County, helping them remain safe and independent in their own homes. We provide: Advocacy, consultation & referrals, Case Management, Home Visits, and Translation/Interpretation Services. Support with Benefit and Rebate Program Applications.

RESTRICTIONS: age 60 plus

12d. QUESTION: Do you have questions about Medicare?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Diana Vasquez

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: I provide assistance with Medicare questions and Medicare plans such as Medicare Supplements and Medicare Advantage Plans. I provide services to persons 65 and over and persons under 65 who have a disability and Medicaid for 24 months, persons with chronic condition and persons who have both Medicaid and Medicare.

RESTRICTIONS: age 64plus

12e. QUESTION: Are you eligible for Social Security benefits?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Social Security Administration on site this year,

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: The Social Security Administration (SSA) is a U S government agency that administers social programs covering Disability, Retirement and Survivors benefits. Social Security will be hosting a booth to answer your benefit eligibility questions and distribute benefit information. If attendees have a valid photo ID (U. S. State Identification Card or State Issue Driver's License), you may also complete an application to replace your Social Security Card.

12f. QUESTION: Are you a homebound older adult who needs help preparing meals?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Meals on Wheels

SERVICE DESCRIPTION:

Meals on Wheels is designed to help restore or maintain health through nutrition and social contact in an effort to keep homebound older adults living in their homes healthy and independently, Ready to eat lunchtime meals are delivered Monday - Friday with frozen meals available for the weekend, if needed. At Project Connect, Meals on Wheels will begin the sign up process for those who are interested in meal delivery. A follow up phone conversation will complete the process and meal delivery will start soon after.

13 Voter Registration

QUESTION: Would you like to register to vote or update your voter registration?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Clerk and Recorder

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: The Weld County Elections office registers eligible electors to vote. To be an eligible elector, you must be 18 years of age or older at the time of the next election, be a US citizen, have resided in Colorado for 22 days immediately before the election you intend to vote in, and not serving a sentence of confinement, detention or parole for a felony conviction. In addition to registering new voters and updating voter records, we will be sharing historical data and providing information on the 2024 election. The information will be process-specific and not candidate or issue-related.

14 Medical Durable Power of Attorney

QUESTION: Are you over 18, and need your Medical Durable Power of Attorney or Living Will?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Systems of Care Initiative (SOI) Sharing the Care

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Medical Durable Power of Attorney (MDPOA) is an advance directive that allows you to choose a person to speak for you when you are physically unable to let others know your healthcare wishes. Anyone age 18 and older can and should have a MDPOA. In Colorado there is no guarantee that your spouse, parent or sibling will have the permission to make medical decisions without an MDPOA. A Living Will gives your MDPOA a guideline for your medical care if you are in a terminal or persistent vegetative state and cannot let others know your healthcare wishes. Today you can complete your MDPOA and/or Living Will. Our staff is available to answer questions, notarize and witness forms.

RESTRICTIONS: Must be 18

HEALTH

15 Women Wellness/ Mammogram

QUESTION: Are you a woman over age 40 who has not had a mammogram in the last year?

SERVICE PROVIDER: North Colorado Medical Center (NCMC) Breast Center

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: We provide mammograms and ultra sounds to women over the age of 40, or under 40 if they have a breast problem (like a lump). They can have insurance, but if they do not, we will assist them with funding for this exam. Our program includes these 7 counties: Weld, Morgan, Sedgwick, Yuma, Phillips, Washington, or Logan, that meet monetary guidelines. They will need to have a health care provider to report their exam to. We are happy to connect them with Weld County Health Department, the Sunrise Clinic, or Planned Parenthood, if they do not have a provider. This is a program that is provided by the NCMC, through generous donations in our community. This includes donations from Human Bean, the Tough enough to Wear Pink Rodeo, Dig Pink at UNC and various events held by schools in our area. These funds supplement the Women's Wellness Connection. We will also be able to schedule your screening mammogram appoint at the Banner Imaging Breast Center at Summit View Medical Commons for a later date. We will have vouchers for screening mammograms available. We are also available to assist women and men, regardless of age, who are having breast symptoms or considered high risk. Men can receive this service if they a problem with their breast (like a lump).

RESTRICTIONS: Must be woman aged 40 years or older, or a younger woman, or man with a breast problem (like a lump).

Women Wellness

QUESTION: Are you a woman over age 40 and in need of a mammogram, Pap smear, or basic blood screenings?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Sunrise Health

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: We provide mammograms and ultra sounds to women over the age of 40, or under 40 if they have a breast problem (like a lump). They can have insurance, but if they do not, we will assist them with funding for this exam. We will also be able to schedule your screening mammogram appoint at the Banner Imaging Breast Center at Summit View Medical Commons for a later date. We will have vouchers for screening mammograms available. We are also available to assist women and men, regardless of age, who are having breast symptoms or considered high risk. Men can receive this service if they a problem with their breast (like a lump).

RESTRICTIONS: Must be a woman age 40 or older, legal resident, and meet income guidelines.

16 Pneumonia Vaccine

QUESTION: Do you need a pneumonia shot AND are a smoker or have heart/lung condition or diabetes?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment (WCDPHE) Immunizations

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Weld County Health Department will be offering Pneumonia vaccination. Pneumovax (PPSVf23) is recommended for persons with the following conditions: diabetes with certain heart/lung conditions such as congestive heart failure and COPD/asthma, alcoholism, liver disease, HIV, chronic renal failure asplenia. Pneumovax is also recommended for persons over the age of 65 or persons 19 years and older who smoke cigarettes.

RESTRICTIONS: None

17 TDAP Vaccine

QUESTION: Would you like a tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (TDAP) vaccination?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment (WCDPHE) Immunizations

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Weld County Health department will be offering TDAP vaccination. The TDAP vaccine protects from tetanus, diphtheria and whooping cough. TDAP is routinely recommended to adolescents entering 6th grade, adults with no record of previous TDAP vaccination and to pregnant women in their 3rd trimester.

RESTRICTIONS: must not have had a tetanus shot in the last 10 years.

18 Tuberculosis Testing

QUESTION: If you have not been screened in the last year or never treated for Tuberculosis, would you like a free screening?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment (WCDPHE)

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: The tuberculosis program provides for evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment for persons with active TB and their contacts. Preventive treatment is available for persons with positive TB tests. Testing, X-rays, and medications can be provided through this program. You must be a Weld County resident to qualify for services. We will be providing Tuberculosis testing.

RESTRICTIONS: Must be a resident of Weld County

#19 HIV Testing

QUESTION: Would you like to be tested for HIV, Syphilis, Gonorrhea and/or Chlamydia?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment (WCDPHE)

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment will be offering Rapid HIV and Syphilis (age 18+) screenings to individuals who have experienced relevant risk or do not know their HIV status. Urine testing for Gonorrhea and Chlamydia will be provided. Additionally, educational and prevention related information will be available.

RESTRICTIONS: 18 or older

#20 Pap Smear Testing

QUESTION: Are you a woman, age 21-64, who hasn't had a pap smear in the last 5 years?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment (WCDPHE)

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Women's Wellness Connection (WWC) provides Pap smears and pelvic exams for women age 21-64 that meet income guidelines. Eligible women will be given an appointment at the WCDPHE to have these services provided.

RESTRICTIONS: 18 or older

#21 A1C Testing

QUESTION: Do you have a family history of diabetes and are concerned about having diabetes?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Weld County Department of Public Health and Environment (WCDPHE)

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Weld County Department of Public Health will provide A1C screenings (for diabetes) and provide recommendations and referrals for follow-up.

RESTRICTIONS: 18 or older

22 Hearing

QUESTION: Would you like a free screening for your hearing?

SERVICE PROVIDER: HEAR USA

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Check to see if you are within normal limits of hearing. It takes approximately five minutes to conduct each hearing screening. After the hearing screening, the consultant will review the audiogram and answer health questions. Let us keep you connected to the people and activities you love!

RESTRICTIONS: None

23 Dental Screenings

QUESTION: Would you like to have a dental screening for cavities?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Sunrise, North Colorado Health Alliance

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Supporting the oral health of people and our community through integrated, affordable, quality dental healthcare and education services. Specializing in low-income, at risk families. We will be offering visual dental screenings and linking patients to dental appointments through Sunrise.

RESTRICTIONS:

24 Health Screenings

QUESTION: Would you like your blood pressure, body mass index, and/or pulse checked or have a question for a nurse?

SERVICE PROVIDER: University of Northern Colorado

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: We will be performing blood pressure, body mass index, pulse, height and weight assessments. We generally write down the participant values within the range of what is considered normal for the participant. The participant can then take this information to the Nurse Practitioner station for consultation if they have concerns.

RESTRICTIONS: None

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WELLNESS

25 Haircuts

QUESTION: Would you like a haircut?

SERVICE PROVIDER: IBMC Students & Design Beauty Academy

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Haircuts will be provided for interested attendees that are hair trims

RESTRICTIONS: None

26 Flu Shot

QUESTION: Would you like a flu shot today?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Walgreens Pharmacy

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Walgreens is providing flu shots for up to 300 individuals aged 7 years or older. This service is not available for those under the age requirement and those who are feeling or may be sick the day of services.

RESTRICTIONS: Aged 7 years or older and feeling healthy today

27 Mental Health

QUESTION: Do you want to learn more about mental health services, complete or schedule an intake or need crisis support?

SERVICE PROVIDER: North Range Behavioral Health (NRBH)

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Do you have questions about mental health services or whether to seek treatment? We can answer your questions and if you are ready to take the first step, we can help you complete or schedule an intake today. Are you a current client of North Range and need help with your account or treatment plan? We can help you connect with the right person to address your situation. Are you or a loved one experiencing a behavioral health emergency? We can help connect you with crisis resources and support.

RESTRICTIONS: Must be 15 years of age or older

28 Chiropractic

QUESTION: Would you like to receive a spinal exam and/or chiropractic adjustment?

SERVICE PROVIDER: Dr Ryan Mayeda

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Mayeda Clinic of Chiropractic will offer free spinal exams and provide chiropractic adjustments to anyone who is interested.

RESTRICTIONS: None

29 Pregnancy

QUESTION: Do you have questions about personal sexual health and need more information on pregnancy or STD's?

SERVICE PROVIDER: The Resource Center for Pregnancy and Personal Health

Participants at Anna Gimmestad Park and the Rodarte Center are engaged in a 10 week program during the summer months Monday-Friday from 1-5 pm for \$25.00. While at these locations they participate in programs such as arts and crafts, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Bookmobile, CSU extensions, swimming and various recreational activities such as dodge ball, basketball, gym games and field activities. Exposure to lead over a long period may cause health effects, especially in children or pregnant women, so it's important to identify its presence and remove any source that may contaminate water as it enters a home or building. Greeley Water is asking people living in houses built before 1981 to complete a 5-minute survey at greeleygov.com/leadsurvey. Greeley Water will hand out individually wrapped "service line test kits" with instructions on how to perform the test on their water service line to determine if it is made of lead. Each baggie will include instructions, a QR Code to the survey, a pen light (service line may be in a dark crawlspace), a magnet and a scratcher. Results of the test will be submitted to Greeley Water via the survey link at greeleygov.com/leadsurvey. Greeley Water will also have staff on site to help people register for WaterSmart which enables households to track their water use and identify leaks early before they result in property damage.

Before families leave, the students will be enrolled in school, receive a backpack and/or school supplies if they need it, they'll receive a gently used book, they can fill out the school meal application if they need to, and they will receive information regarding a variety of school-based programs include the Migrant Education Program, Summit program, volunteer program, GEAR UP, and the Parent Involvement services available at the schools. Families may also receive school bus route information as needed.

SERVICE PROVIDER: CSU Educational Opportunity Center

SERVICE DESCRIPTION: Funded by the US Department of Education, the Weld County Educational Opportunity Center (EOC) programs offer FREE services to qualified individuals without a degree, to help them achieve their career and educational goals. These services include information on vocational and certificate programs, career assessment and career options, counseling and information on two year and four year colleges/universities, assistance with college admissions and application process, as well as guidance on secondary school reentry and referrals to GED and ESL programs. An important objective of the program is to counsel participants on financial aid options, including basic financial planning skills, provide assistance with the financial aid scholarship search process and, assistance in completing the Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA). The primary focus of the EOC is to provide services to first generation individuals age 19 or older with limited incomes, veterans and military-connected family members, and unaccompanied, homeless or foster care youth.
